

## Representative Cases for Jay Cordell Horton

### Medical Malpractice

Failure to timely diagnose and treat bowel obstruction in toddler resulting loss of bowel and need for lifetime intravenous feeding. Settled for \$10 million; another at \$8.85mil.

Post partum bleeding complication in mother after vaginal delivery of triplets resulting in hypovolemia and brain damage. Settled for \$7.6 mil

Failure to repond to fetal distress in various (>12) cases resulting in hypoxic encephalopathy and various degrees of residual brain damage. Settlements ranging from \$1.2 to \$4.5 million.

Failure to diagnose cancer leading to metastases and terminal illness in > 12 cases resulting in settlements ranging from \$450,000 to \$2.5 million.
