Once the eviction moratorium is lifted, California courts expect a tsunami of eviction cases. Join this training and give back to those in need by:

- Becoming a volunteer mediator (recommended for those with at least two years of practice), or
- Serving as a “Remote Attorney of the Day” giving information to unrepresented landlords or tenants during the court of the mediation, or
- Helping landlords or tenants complete the forms needed to get rental assistance.

Mediations will take place **remotely** in various county courts Monday through Saturday, at various times; schedule your shift at your convenience. Attorneys licensed in California are eligible, and malpractice insurance is provided. MCLE credit for this training by Alameda County Bar Association.
